

USDiveShows Retail Sales Policy

USDiveShows (The Show) has adopted a sales policy for each of its scuba and adventure shows. Its policy in keeping with local and state laws requires sellers to obtain a local sellers license and display such certification in their booth during the show.

Transactions may begin at the show with only the sellers local selling permit held at their place of business but completion of the sale, such as delivery/pick-up, must take place from the seller's regular place of business.

The Show also supports pricing policies of manufacturers and suppliers of products.

The Show prohibits all "cash & carry" transactions involving the retail distribution of tanks, dry suits, regulators, computers, buoyancy compensators, rebreathers, knives and spear guns and pole spears. Orders for dive gear mentioned above may be taken for delivery at a later date or in a location other than the site of The Show.

This policy does not cover masks, fins, snorkels, photographs, bags, clothing, books, jewelry, DVDs, cameras and accessories, lights, and watches. If you intend to sell items not specifically covered herein, you must get prior written approval from The Show. All retail sales are subject to the confines of all applicable local, state, federal, and tax laws. Local resale number must be obtained for any retail sales and delivery at the show.

The wheeling into the exhibit hall of stock for retail sales is strictly prohibited during public show hours.
